## Leading The Implementation Of The Digital Curriculum In Secondary Schools

The programme will support school middle-leaders to improve the quality of digital learning provision by planning and implement the Digital Competence Framework (DCF) within secondary schools.

It is assumed that schools attending will have developed whole-school strategic approaches for the development of digital learning.

The supported sessions will develop and provide support for:

- » Understanding of the DCF and its content
- » An understanding of the link between the current ICT National Curriculum and DCF
- » Mapping the DCF to current practice
- » Ideas for resource management
- » Practical approaches to integrating the DCF and joint practice development across the curriculum with specific focus on each strand of the DCF
- » Implementing the DCF at KS4 with specific focus on the Welsh Baccalaureate
- » Creating an implementation plan for staff development
- » Extending learning within and beyond the classroom and ensuring access for disadvantaged pupils

## Leading The Digital Curriculum (Primary)

The importance of digital learning has become a key issue for development in schools across Wales.

Digital Competence is the third cross-curriculum responsibility and the first element of the new curriculum for Wales to become available. Schools will need to be confident in their approaches to adopting the Digital Competence Framework across the curriculum by 2018. The use of technology to support teaching and learning supplements the expectations around the development of cross-curricular competences.

The programme will support school middle-leaders to develop:

- » Curriculum planning
- » Resource management
- » Citizenship and online safety education
- » Staff development and 'digital confidence'
- » Building capacity across the school
- » Practical approaches to integrating the DCF across the curriculum
- » Developing pupil leadership
- » Strategies for closing the attainment gap for disadvantaged pupils
